Graduation Rates 200 Overview

Welcome to the IPEDS Graduation Rates 200 (GR200) survey component. Data Reporting Reminders

Changes to reporting for 2019-20

• There are clarifications to the terms "transfer-in student" and "transfer-out student".

• The term 'contact hour' has been replaced with the term 'clock hour'.

- As a clarification to the reporting of transfers-out, if a student transfers out of an institution and goes to
 another institution within the same coordinated system, they should be counted as a transfer-out student.
 Since each reporting entity that has an IPEDS UnitID is recognized as an individual reporting institution for
 Graduation Rates purposes, only report completers if that campus confers the award or degree.
